The wine's character

Thanks to its position, Vosne-Romanée Premier Cru "Les Petits Monts" is a wine of great complexity. With low acidity and fine tannins, it shows ripe fruit aromas and floral essence. Forest floor and humus meet cherry brandy and peony, later evolving toward leather. Sometimes slightly smoky, it delivers a generous, forthright, and velvety palate. Its finesse and elegance make it a beautifully harmonious wine.

Terroir, origin, and identity

This appellation, located above Grand Crus like Richebourg, enjoys an exceptional position. The elevated nature of certain parcels is often marked by the toponym "mont." Here, shape, exposure, and dimensions are recorded through highly descriptive names—"Petits Monts" referring simply to its modest scale.



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
